Our techs and Americorps members are busy working in the field providing critical repairs for our vulnerable neighbors. We repaired a home in East Palo Alto, renovating the roof, mending a fence, and installing a security door. This ensured that the homeowner was safe and secure as she sheltered in place.



Last week we addressed a dangerous tripping hazard at a Sunnyvale home. The owner has mobility issues and we were able to replace the old deck with a platform that is one level. She can now use her backyard and enjoy the sunshine safely.
