The Opportunity and Commitment

Every year since 1989, the last Saturday in April has been National Rebuilding Day (NRD) for Rebuilding Together Peninsula. On that day Rebuilding Together Peninsula (RTP) united thousands of volunteers to rehabilitate homes and community facilities, revitalizing Peninsula communities from Sunnyvale to Daly City.

Then, in 2020, COVID-19 hit and we had to pivot our programs to fit the changing environment. We canceled National Rebuilding Day and combined our NRD and Team Build projects in order to continue to provide critical home repairs for our vulnerable neighbors in need. We performed repairs throughout the spring, summer, and fall. Since we could not have volunteers, we relied on our dedicated skilled RTP technicians and subcontractors to complete our work.

Looking ahead to 2021, there are still many unknowns. While we anticipate having volunteers, we will continue to adjust as needed to ensure the safety of our homeowners, staff, and volunteers.

Volunteers:

- Smaller teams at a time on a site.
- Self-contained groups - no combined sponsor groups.
- Volunteer days will be spread out over several days or weeks depending on the scope of the project and number of volunteers.

Safety Protocols:

- All work will be outdoors - landscaping, yard clean-up, debris removal, painting, ramp building, fences, gutter cleaning, deck repair, power washing.
- Social distancing.
- Mandatory mask wearing.

- Washing stations and hand sanitizer will be provided.

Every project is unique. Each site comes with a different history, specific needs, and its own scope of work. Volunteering creates a lasting impression and life-changing experience for both our volunteers and our neighbors in need.

Sponsors furnish financial support along with a volunteer team that includes a Volunteer Captain. RTP staff will identify your project and train and support your volunteers throughout the process. Sponsors have the option of designating their own Construction Captain should they have an interested skilled volunteer to plan and lead their group's repair activities.

Note: It is not mandatory to provide volunteers. Sponsors can fund RTP programs, helping to fund those areas where repairs are most needed.

Construction Captain (CC)

The CC acts as the project manager on the assigned site. They are responsible for planning and managing a safe, quality repair project that provides a meaningful and enjoyable experience for the volunteers and the homeowner. They manage site-related paperwork.

Volunteer Captain (VC)

The VC works in partnership with the CC to ensure that volunteers have a positive experience. They help the CC complete repairs and manage the logistics for the site and the volunteers.

Sponsor Representative (SR)

The SR is the main contact between RTP and the sponsoring organization. They identify a VC for their organization and ensure the sponsors agreement is submitted and the financial commitment is fulfilled.
