



As you will see in this report, we had a busy year. Our year-round minor home repair program helped 132 families stay safe and secure in their homes. Over 45 corporations, foundations, and service organizations sponsored National Rebuilding Day, our signature volunteer-driven annual event that transformed 40 homes and community facilities.

Dreams Happen, our biannual fundraising gala, brought together talented architects and builders to create beautiful and inspiring playhouses for auction. 
cannot work from home. But as an essential service ourselves, RTP's work continues. One grateful homeowner warmed my heart:
